ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

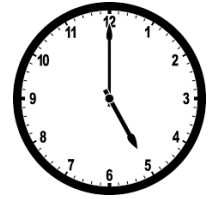

- Read small story from Jatak Tales and make the Word Wall of the New words from the story. (Roll no. 21-31)

- Do one writing page daily in Cursive Writing Book.

- मस्ती की पाठशाला: छुट्टियों का नया पिटारा
- नन्हा जासूस - “पुरानी यादों की खोज”
घर की कोई पुरानी चीज़ खोजें (जैसे घड़ी, बर्तन, सिक्का आदि)। उसके बारे में बड़ों से पूछें और उसका चित्र बनाकर 4-5 पंक्तियाँ लिखें। (Roll no. 1-10)
 - शब्दों का जादूगर
अखबार से 1 चित्र काटें। उसके 2 मजेदार नाम सोचें और उनसे एक छोटा वाक्य बनाकर पुराने कैलेंडर पर चिपकाएँ। (Roll no. 11-20)

MATHS



Do this work in Maths copy.

- Write the name and age of your family members, now arrange the age in Ascending and Descending order. Write the number name of age. (Roll no.1 - 10)
- Write the birth year of your family members and find the place value of each digit and draw abacus also. (Roll No. 11 - 20)
- Write your routine of any one day with showing time in clocks. Ex. 5 o'clock - I go for jogging in the morning at 5 o'clock. (Roll No. 21 - 31)
- Revise tables 2 to 15 regularly.

EVS

- Draw a big tree with 3 branches. Label the branches:
Energy Food - gives us power → Rice, Chapati, Potato
Body Building Food - makes us strong → Milk, Egg, Dal
Protective Food - keeps us healthy → Fruits, Vegetables (Roll no.1 - 10)
- Seed to Plant Diary
You need: Cotton, bowl, moong/chana seeds, water
What to do: Place wet cotton in a bowl. Put 5-6 seeds on it. Water daily. Watch sprouts grow for 7 days. Draw 1 picture each day in a notebook. . (Roll No. 11 - 20)
- Draw eyes, nose, mouth, ears on paper plate to make a face.
For each part, stick a food:
 - Eyes: Stick red tomato cutout. "We see the tomato"
 - Nose: Stick flower near nose. "We smell biryani"
 - Tongue: Stick ice cream on mouth. "We taste ice cream"
 - Ears: Stick chips near ear. "We hear crunch of chips"
 - Hands: Draw hands holding roti. "We feel roti is soft" (Roll No. 21 - 31)



COMPUTER

- Draw 4-5 boxes on A4 sheet. Draw/paste pictures showing uses of computer. Write one line for each use. Add colourful borders. (Roll no. 1-15)
- Draw a keyboard layout on A4 sheet. Colour vowels (A, E, I, O, U) differently. Highlight number keys. Use foam or paper cut-outs for keys. (Roll no. 15-31)
