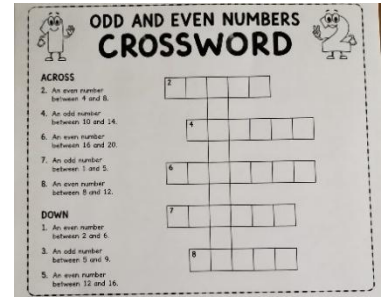

## MATHS

- Prepare given crossword in maths copy. (Roll No. 1 -10)
- Draw a flower on a coloured chart paper cut it and write the number using sketch pen.
- Write a number (ex. 4) in the center of the flower. On each petal, write multiplication facts (4x1, 4x2, 4x3, etc.). Solve and write answers on petals (4, 8, 12, 16\*.....) Prepare for Table of 7,8,9 (Roll No. 11 – 20)
- Use Ice Cream sticks and make bundles of 10. Show numbers using bundles (tens) and single sticks (ones) (Roll No. 21 – 31)
- Revise tables 2 to 10 regularly



## EVS

- Draw a big plate on paper. Divide it into 4 parts. Draw or paste pictures of: 1 fruit, 1 vegetable, 1 grain, 1 milk product. Write their names. Example: "Apple - Fruit", "Chapati - Grain". (Roll no. 1-10)
- Make 2 lists with drawings:  
Food we cook: Rice, Dal, Potato  
Food we eat raw: Apple, Cucumber, Banana (Roll no. 11-20)
- Use paper to make your favourite fruit: apple, mango, or orange. Stick it in your notebook and write 2 lines: "My favourite fruit is mango. It is sweet and yellow." (Roll no. 21-31)

## COMPUTER

- Imagine your own computer. Draw it. Will it have wings? Will it talk? Colour it and give it a name. (Roll no. 1-15)
- Draw or paste pictures of 5 places where we see computers: School, Bank, Shop etc. Write 1 line on what they do there. (Roll no. 15-31)
