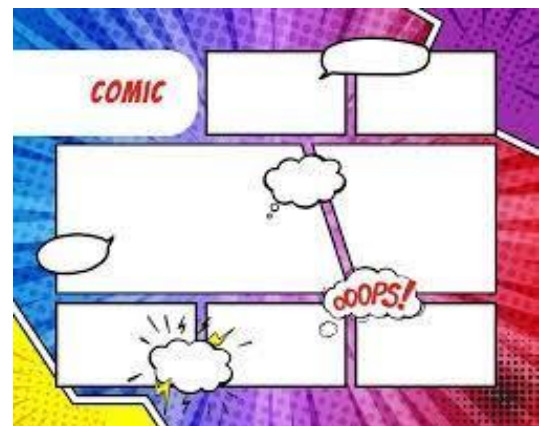
ROLL NO. 1-10: COMIC STRIP DESIGNING

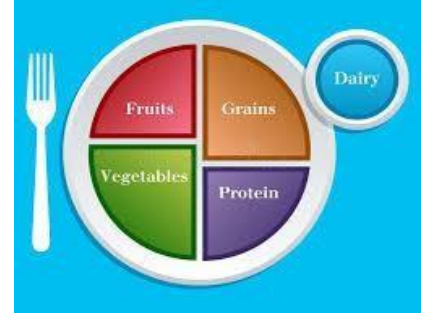
